credence: belief that something is true; the quality of being believed or accepted as something true or real

credible: able to be believed; reasonable to trust or believe

creed: a statement of the basic beliefs of a religion; an idea or set of beliefs that guides the actions of a person or group

phobia: an extremely strong dislike or fear of someone or something

claustrophobic: having a fear of being in closed or small spaces; used to describe a small closed in room with little space
